Our Child Safe Officers are specially trained staff you can turn to with any concerns about the safety, neglect, abuse or wellbeing of a child in our Marymede community. Whether you're unsure about a situation, need guidance on your reporting obligations, or want to raise a concern confidentially — they are your first point of contact.

Speak to a Child Safe Officer if you:

- Have a concern about a student's safety or wellbeing
- Receive a disclosure from a student
- Are unsure whether or how to report something
- Need advice on child safety policies or procedures

Please note: Reporting to a Child Safe Officer does not remove your personal legal obligation to make a mandatory report if your own concerns meet the required threshold.

All concerns will be handled with care, confidentiality and respect.

Marymede operates under the Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools (MACS) Child Safety Framework and Victoria's 11 Child Safe Standards.
